

Before you start:


This calendar works for **any year**. Simply follow these steps:

- what month are you in today? Find the page with that month
- what date is it today?
 (e.g. example shown is 10th of the month)
 Go to that number and mark a cross
- what day of the week is today?
 (e.g. example shown is Wednesday)
 Go to the top line, write in the day above today's date, then continue writing in the days from there onwards
- what day of the week is the last day of the month? (e.g. Thursday 31st) so make sure you start the next month on the following day (e.g. Friday 1st)
- and off you go!







